



## Parking regulations

for car parks at the “BMW International Open 2020”

### Article 1 Scope of application

1. The visitor's entry into the car park, whether by vehicle or on foot, shall be deemed acceptance of the parking regulations. This applies to all BMW International Open designated car parks throughout the event grounds.

### Article 2 Entry and parking rights

1. There is no entitlement to the availability of a parking space, especially if the car park's capacity has been reached.
2. The car parks shall be opened as required and assigned to visitors by stewards.
3. The right to use the car parks shall lapse if the parked vehicle is not covered by liability insurance and/or has had its number plate revoked and/or is not in possession of a number plate with a valid test sticker and/or the parked vehicle has a leaking tank/engine or is not in a roadworthy condition or is otherwise in a potentially dangerous condition.
4. Parked vehicles must not contain any items that could pose a hazard to other visitors.

### Article 3 Traffic regulations and conduct in the car parks

1. The car parks shall be governed by the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulations (StVO) and Road Traffic Licensing Regulations (StVZO), as amended.
2. Vehicles may only be parked within approved and designated parking spaces. Vehicles parked outside indicated parking spaces or that are obstructing roadways or emergency service access routes may be towed away without warning. The costs so incurred shall be borne by the offender.
3. Vehicles are to be driven at walking pace within car parks.
4. Drivers shall refrain from unnecessary engine idling and unnecessary driving manoeuvres within car parks.
5. All car park roads and pathways, installations and facilities are to be kept in a clean and proper state.
6. All persons are requested not to throw away litter, packaging material and empty containers but to dispose of them in the litter bins provided.
7. All visitors shall conduct themselves in such a way that persons do not come to harm, are not put in danger nor - more than is unavoidable in the circumstances - hindered or inconvenienced.
8. Entry to and exit from the car parks shall be solely via the entrances and exits provided for this purpose.

### Article 4 Security staff

1. There will be no surveillance of parked vehicles. Vehicles are parked at one's own risk. Security staff shall be employed to provide instructions and not for keeping vehicles under surveillance.
2. The visitor shall be instructed not to leave valuables unattended, nor to leave any cash, bank and credit cards or other valuables in the vehicle.
3. Visitors shall be required to comply with instructions from security personnel, the event organiser's employees or other of his representatives, the police, fire brigade, rescue and ambulance service. This also applies to instructions given by loudspeaker.

### Article 5 Infringements

1. Individuals contravening the parking regulations or who fail to comply with instructions and orders from security staff, the event organiser's employees or other of his representatives, the police, fire brigade, rescue and ambulance service, may be prevented from entering the car



parks by security staff and the police or be expelled from them. In this case, the vehicles so affected may be towed away without warning. The costs so incurred shall be borne by the offender. In such cases, the event organiser and security service reserve the right to press a criminal charge for trespass.

2. In the event of serious or repeated infringements, a parking ban may be imposed for the remainder of the event.

## **§ 6 Liability**

1. The event organiser shall be liable for compensation for breach of contractual or non-contractual obligations, especially tortious liability, only in the event of intent or gross negligence. The aforementioned limitation of liability shall not apply to injury to life, limb or health.
2. The aforementioned limitation of liability shall apply in equal measure to the event organiser's performing and vicarious agents.
3. The aforementioned provisions do not constitute a shift in the burden of proof to the detriment of the event visitor.
4. Persons who have suffered injury or loss shall be required to contact the event organiser forthwith and notify him of the injuries/loss.

## **§ 7 Final provisions**

1. These parking regulations shall come into effect at 18:00 on 19 June 2020 and remain in force until 18:00 on 29 June 2020.
2. The parking regulations shall be promulgated by means of leaflets at the entrance.
3. The parking regulations shall be supplemented by the provisions of the site regulations.
