



Site regulations

for the "BMW International Open 2020" event site.

Article 1 Presence within the site

1. The visitor's entry into the event area shall be deemed acceptance of the site regulations.
2. The visitor's presence shall only be permitted in that part of the event site that is open to visitors.
3. There is no entitlement to enter the event area.

Article 2 Security screening

1. The event organiser's security staff shall be entitled to search visitors – including by means of technical equipment – for their possession of prohibited items, and to take custody of them.

Article 3 Conduct in the event area

1. All visitors shall conduct themselves in the event area in such a way that persons do not come to harm, are not put in danger nor - more than is unavoidable in the circumstances - hindered or inconvenienced.
2. Visitors shall be required to comply with instructions from security personnel, the event organiser's employees or other of his representatives, the police, fire brigade, rescue and ambulance service. This also applies to instructions given by loudspeaker and other media.
3. Entry to and exit from the site shall be solely via the entrances and exits provided for this purpose.
4. All site access routes shall be kept unobstructed. Notwithstanding these site regulations, any further necessary orders may be enacted on a case by case basis to prevent or eliminate hazards to life, health or property. Instructions issued by the police or security staff to this end are to be complied with.
5. All persons entering the site are requested not to throw away litter, packaging material and empty containers but to dispose of them in the litter bins provided on-site.
6. Please note the following instructions on the use of smart phones on the tournament site and on photography using smart phones:
 - a. Mobile telephones must be set to quiet at all times and everywhere.
 - b. The flash feature must be deactivated at all times and everywhere.
 - c. Please show consideration for players and other spectators. Please comply with announcements by players, marshals and officials.
 - d. Subject to these conditions, you may take photographs for private use at all times and everywhere – but only with your smart phone.
 - e. Video footage may only be recorded away from the golf course (e.g. driving range).
 - f. Data use (e.g. email, social media) is permitted everywhere.
 - g. Telephone calls are only permitted away from the golf course (e.g. public area).

Article 4 Prohibitions

1. Visitors shall be prohibited from carrying the following items:
 - 1.1. weapons as construed by the Arms Law;
 - 1.2. objects and items capable of being used as weapons; blunt weapons, sharp weapons, stabbing weapons or projectiles;
 - 1.3. items that give the appearance of being a weapon, for example toy weapons, replica weapons or deactivated weapons;
 - 1.4. fireworks, flare cartridges, smoke powders, smoke bombs or other pyrotechnic articles;
 - 1.5. In high-density crowd areas or other areas defined by the event organiser: bottles, cups, jugs, cans or other objects made of glass or other fragile, spintering or especially hard material;
 - 1.6. alcoholic beverages not purchased on the premises;
 - 1.7. drugs and stimulants as construed by the Narcotics Law;
 - 1.8. racist, xenophobic, national socialist, sexist or political propaganda material;



- 1.9. any advertising, commercial, political or religious items, including banners, signage, symbols and leaflets and the like, as well as all kinds of promotional and commercial items and materials that have not been approved by the event organiser;
 - 1.10. aerosol cans, corrosive, inflammable, colouring or other dangerous substances or vessels containing substances that are injurious to health or highly flammable, with the exception of the customary pocket lighters;
 - 1.11. bulky items such as ladders, boxes, oversize bags, suitcases;
 - 1.12. laser pointers;
 - 1.13. drones and other remotely-controllable flying objects;
 - 1.14. other objects that might compromise the event's safety.
 - 1.15. Dogs are not permitted on-site.
2. It is also forbidden:
- 2.1. to enter areas and rooms that are manifestly not permitted for general use (e.g. roped-off areas, work and security areas);
 - 2.2. to damage, write on, paint or affix by means of adhesive or otherwise deface plant, facilities or routes; to throw any objects or spill any liquids, especially in the direction of persons;
 - 2.3. While present on the event site, it is strictly forbidden to use electronic devices of any description to collect and/or disseminate data or information that is in any way related to the outcome, the progress of, conduct or any other aspect of the game, for betting or any other unlicensed commercial purposes.

Article 5 Infringements

1. Individuals contravening the site regulations or who fail to comply with instructions and orders from security staff, the event organiser's employees or other of his representatives, the police, fire brigade, rescue and ambulance service, or who are evidently under the influence of intoxicating substances, may be prevented from entering the event area by security staff and the police or be expelled from it. In such cases, the event organiser and security service reserve the right to press a criminal charge for trespass.
2. In the event of serious or repeated infringements, a parking ban may be imposed for the remainder of the event.

§ 6 Liability

1. The event organiser shall be liable for compensation for breach of contractual or non-contractual obligations, especially tortious liability, only in the event of intent or gross negligence. The aforementioned limitation of liability shall not apply to injury to life, limb or health.
2. The aforementioned limitation of liability shall apply in equal measure to the event organiser's performing and vicarious agents.
3. The aforementioned provisions do not constitute a shift in the burden of proof to the detriment of the event visitor.
4. Persons who have suffered injury or loss shall be required to contact the event organiser forthwith and notify him of the injuries/loss.

§ 7 Final provisions

1. These site regulations shall come into effect at 18:00 on 19 June 2020 and remain in force until 18:00 on 29 June 2020.
2. The site regulations shall be promulgated by means of leaflets at the entrance to the event site.
